PROJECT / ITEM	FUNDING REQUIRED
General Donations: All contributions will enable Music 4 U to continue its valuable work. Your donation may fund our general running costs, or support disadvantaged young people, and those with special needs or disability, to take part in music activities, e.g. we recently provided funding for some young carers to attend a series of dance workshops.	All donations are gratefully received
Musical equipment: This includes items such as percussion instruments for workshops.	£250
Costumes and clothing: We need an ongoing supply for our young performers.	£250
Youth Chorus performances: Some audiences are unable to experience live entertainment due to illness, disability and/or location. Previous audiences have included families at a children's hospice and the elderly. At present, specific funding requests include entertainment for the profoundly disabled and their carers.	£500
Photocopier: We require a compact machine that will take care of our daily photocopying needs.	£1,000
Recording opportunities: Our young members, who sell their CDs at performances to raise further funds - a perfect example of 'children helping children through music'.	£2,000
Glasgow event: Our youngsters from across the North East will have a starring role at a high profile charity event in Glasgow later this year - but we need to get them there. Can you help?	£2,000
Vehicle: We need a spacious vehicle to carry staff and equipment to workshops and performance events.	£7,500
Workshops: Musical activity workshops for the profoundly disabled.	£1,000
Happy Feet: A series of confidence-building school holiday dance workshops where young people, including those with special needs, have a special opportunity to work with a professional choreographer.	£3,000
Youth Chorus: Due to high demand, we need funding to run a second Youth Chorus for up to fifty 7-16 year olds who want to have fun singing together. This funding would allow youngsters to join who live in Aberdeenshire, and are unable to get to our Dyce meetings, including those with special needs and those from areas of financial deprivation.	£8,500
